GENERAL INFORMATION

Students must be enrolled in an LSMSA Virtual online course in order to receive a username and password. Usernames and passwords will be emailed to the registration email provided. If the student cannot locate the login information email, the school administrator must contact our office and request the username and password. The school may call 800-256-2854 (8:00am -4:00pm M-F) or email to wirtualschool@lsmsa.edu.

COMPUTER REQUIREMENTS

Students must have a computer or tablet with a reliable internet connection in order to access the course material and complete work in the course. You cannot successfully complete work for a course using only a phone.

NOTE - 'POP-UP' windows need to be allowed in any browser you use and you need to allow tracking 'cookies' for the http://live.lsmsa.edu website.



LOGIN

Students will access the course at http://live.lsmsa.edu/moodle/login/index.php



To log in, students must type their username and password exactly with no space prior to or within. The username and password is emailed to the student via the email provided when the student was enrolled.

Once a student has successfully logged into the LSMSA Virtual School portal, they will land on the 'home' page.

In order to enter the course, the student must click on the 'course' name under COURSE OVERVIEW.




NAVIGATION

When a student enters the course, they will see a WEEKLY ANNOUNCEMENT from the instructor and a NAVIGATION BAR with all of the learning units.


Students will be instructed each week on which units and assignments/tests must be completed. A master schedule for the semester is also available so that students may anticipate what needs to be completed in the future.

The course page has several blocks on either side of the main center pane. All course content will show up in the main pane. Occasionally items will show up in 'POP-UP' windows or in a 'new' window.



BREAD CRUMB TRAIL NAVIGATION

Students may also use the 'bread crumb' trail which is at the top of the page just under the LSMSA logo. As a student opens areas of the course this trail expands. To navigate back, simply click on the previous item or the course name which will always go back to the course main page.



- You can go back to the "home" page by clicking MY HOME.
- You may also hit the 'back' button on a page to return to the last item that was open. This is usable throughout the course but is not accessible when completing a test.

LOG OUT



When a student is done working in the course shell, they need to click the 'LOGOUT' link in the upper right corner of the page drop down next to their name. This is important and prevents anyone from access your account.
